

Change email ports on an iPhone

This article will guide you through the process of changing the incoming and outgoing ports for email on your iPhone.

Outgoing Port

1. Start on the home screen.



2. Click the **Settings** icon.
3. Click **Mail, Contacts, Calendars**.



4. Select the Hosting.com mail account for which you are changing the ports.
5. To change the outgoing port, scroll down to **Outgoing Mail Server** and click the **SMTP** button.



6. This will list the SMTP settings for the account and server. Click the server in the list. It is typically listed under **Primary Server**.



7. On this screen the **SMTP** port will be listed. Click the port and there you can enter in the new port information. Should be 366.



Incoming Port

1. Start on the home screen.



2. Click the **Settings** icon.
3. Click **Mail, Contacts, Calendars**.



4. Select the Hosting.com mail account for which you are changing the ports.
5. To change the incoming port, scroll down to **Outgoing Mail Server** and click the **Advanced** button.



6. Scroll down to **Incoming Settings** and the incoming **Server Port** will be listed. Click the port and there you can enter in the new port information.
